

How to apply for a mooring permit:

Step 1:

After arriving at the Harbormaster's Home Page, look under the header at the top of the page that says "Town of Cushing, Maine Harbormaster." You will see a light blue bar with the links "Home," "Mooring Rules," "Mooring Application," etc.

Step 2:

Click on the link that says "Mooring Application."

Step 4:

Press the light blue “Submit Application” button on the bottom right of the page when all of your information is filled in.

If the Harbormaster approves your submission, you will receive a copy of your Mooring Permit.


How to search for a mooring by name:

Step 1:


After clicking “View Map Listing,” if your screen looks similar to this:



Press the zoom out (-) button several times until you are satisfied.




After zooming out, the picture should look something like this:




To zoom back in, press the zoom in button (+).



You can also see a satellite view of the map by clicking on the “Satellite” box on the upper right hand corner of the Google® Map.



To return to your search results, click the link that says “View Text Listing.”



Step 5:

If after typing your name into the search bar your name appears on the screen, you have a mooring permit. You can click on your name to view your permit.

After viewing your permit, if you notice that anything is incorrect, please click on the link in the light blue bar that says “Contact,” and notify the Harbormaster of corrections that need to be made.




Step 6:

If no results appear in your search return to the list of all moorings, by clicking on the link that says “Mooring Listing” at the bottom of the title picture.



After clicking “Owner Name,” the website will take you to a page that shows you the names of everyone with a mooring permit. The names are listed in alphabetical order by last name. Look for your name in this list. You may have to click the numbers on the upper right hand side of the list to move from page to page if your last name does not appear on the first page.



If you find your name in the list, you have a Mooring Permit.

If you do not see your name on the list and you were unable to find your name after completing a search in the search bar, then you do not have a

Mooring Permit. If you would like one, please follow the steps for “How to apply for a Mooring Permit” to submit your information.

If you have trouble with any step in this process, please call the harbormaster.



How to navigate the “Contact” page on the website:

Step 1:

From the Harbormaster Home Page, click the link that says “Contact” on the left hand side of the light blue bar under the “Town of Cushing, Maine Harbormaster” header.
